WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- State the benefits of introducing an environmental management system (EMS), specifically:
 - ISO 14001
 - Company EMS

CONTENT

Delegates will be issued with course notes, which will give information relating to the important issues when considering environmental liability including risk assessment, hazards and control measures in the working environment.

LEARNING APPROACH

The theory part of the training will be delivered by presentation, which will be tutor lead, with support of a Power Point presentation, video and question sessions. The content of the programme will be 80% theory and 20% practical.
