

Course Title: Personal Track Safety
Course Code: PTS
Duration: 2 Days
Location: Clapham, Crewe, Derby, York or Customer's Own Site

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Any person aged 18 or over that are required to carry out duties on or near a railway line and does not currently hold a valid Personal Track Safety Certificate. People aged 16 and 17 may attend and are permitted to hold a PTS Certificate, however they are only permitted on or near the line under the supervision of a Controller of Site Safety.

OBJECTIVES

On successful completion of the course the delegate will be able to, in accordance with Railway Group Standards:

- Demonstrate their ability to interpret correctly Rule Book, Track Safety Handbook (TSH) and relevant local instructions when required to go on or near the line
- Demonstrate their understanding and ability to follow a safe system of work

CONTENT

- Drugs and Alcohol Policy
- Railway environment and the track terms
- Dangers on or near the line
- Working on or near the line
- Emergency Action
- AC electrified lines
- DC electrified lines
- Track visit

LEARNING APPROACH

Instructor led classroom and practical sessions including a site visit. Theory and practical assessments are included.

FEATURES

Delegates will be provided with a 'Track Safety Handbook' when attending this course. On successful completion of this event an application will be sent to NCCA for a competence certificate valid for two years.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

- A valid medical certificate that meets the requirements of Railway Group Standard GE/RT 8067
- A Valid Drugs and Alcohol Screening indicating a negative result that meets requirements of Railway Group Standard GE/RT 8070
- A high visibility vest, hard hat, suitable outdoor clothing and safety footwear with mid-sole protection are required on this event
- NCCA site ID and address of sponsoring organisation.
